**ORDER**


Having heard the comments and considered the proposals of the parties presented to this Court relative to the scheduling of the depositions of plaintiffs and physicians in the Initial Discovery Pool, the Court **ORDERS**:

- The parties shall subpoena any case-specific witnesses they intend to depose if that witness's deposition has not already been scheduled.
- Those subpoenas will be issued and served no later than January 11, 2019.
- If any witness fails to comply with a subpoena, he or she shall,

upon motion from either party, be ordered to appear before the Court and show cause why the witness should not be held in contempt.

As a result of the foregoing and with consent of counsel for the parties, Practice and Procedure Order No. 13 [Doc. No. 392] is hereby amended so as to extend each of the pending deadlines stated therein by 60 days.
