William H. Thomas, Jr. (Atlanta division)


In addition, Samuel L. Lucas is appointed as Chair of the Committee for a term of two years beginning July 15, 2022.

The work of the Committee shall be guided by Local Rule 83.1 and Appendix G to the Local Rules (*Rules Governing the Committee on Discipline*). Pursuant to Local Rule 83.1(F), the Committee has the power to investigate all charges of professional misconduct referred to it by the Court. At the request of the Committee, the Clerk is authorized to issue subpoenas and subpoenas *duces tecum* in connection with the investigation. The Committee will prepare findings of fact and conclusions of law and make a recommendation to the Chief Judge. The members of the

Committee are representatives of the Court and enjoy all immunities while acting in their official capacities on behalf of the Court.

The District Court Executive / Clerk of Court shall provide staff support to the Committee.
