IN RE: AMENDMENT TO MAXIMUM FEE SCHEDULE FOR REALTIME SERVICES

ORDER

Pursuant to action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States at its March 2011 session, and pursuant to action taken by the judges of this court at their meeting on October 13, 2011, this court adopts a revised maximum transcript fee schedule for realtime services ordered through the certified court reporters of this court, effective November 1, 2011.

The revised maximum fee schedule for realtime services, based on the number of realtime connections (feeds), as approved, is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

The District Court Executive/Clerk of Court for the Northern District of Georgia shall cause this new fee schedule to be posted at the public counters of all divisional offices of the Clerk of the District Court, posted on the court's public web page, included in the Court Reporter Management Plan for the Northern District of Georgia, and transmitted for approval to the Judicial Council of the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

Ordinary	A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.

<u>Daily</u>	A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it actually is a court day.
<u>Hourly</u>	A transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.
Realtime	A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment. A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
Transcript in CJA Cases	In multi-defendant cases involving CJA defendants, no more than one transcript should be purchased from the court reporter on behalf of CJA

transcript should be purchased from the court reporter on behalf of CJA defendants. One of the appointed counsel or the clerk of court should arrange for the duplication, at commercially competitive rates, of enough copies of the transcript for each of the CJA defendants for whom a transcript has been approved. The cost of such duplication will be charged to the CJA appropriation. This policy would not preclude the furnishing of duplication services by the court reporter at the commercially competitive rate.
