QUALIFYING QUESTIONS - (Civil Cases, Judge Jones)

1. Does any member of the panel know(Plaintiff's attorney)?
2. Does any member of the panel know any employees of, or has any member of the panel or their immediate family worked for or been represented by the law firm of?
3. Does any member of the panel know (Defendant's attorney)?
4. Does any member of the panel know any employees of, or has any member of the panel or their immediate family worked for or been represented by the law firm of?
5. Does anyone know Plaintiff in the case?
6. Does anyone know Defendant in the case?
7. Does anyone know any of the following individuals who may be witnesses in this case? [Court will instruct the attorneys to name their witnesses.]
8. If you are selected to sit on this case, will you be able to render a verdict solely on the evidence presented at trial and in the context of the law as I will give it to you in my instructions.?
9. Is there any member of the panel who has any special disability or problem that would make serving as a member of this jury difficult or impossible?
10. Does any juror hold any belief, religious, or otherwise, which discourages or prevents jury service?
11. Have you formed or expressed any opinion as to which of the parties ought to prevail in this case?
12. Have you any wish or desire as to which of the parties ought to prevail in this case?

13. For cases involving insurance or other special matters, qualify the jury as to

any special relationships as follows:

Does any juror have any interest in the outcome of this case or any interest arising out of business relations with a party to this case?
Is anyone a stockholder, (or policy holder in the case of a mutual insurance company), officer, director, agent, or employee of? (insert name of company having interest in case as party, insurer, or otherwise)
Is anyone related by blood or marriage to any stockholder (or policyholder if applicable), officer, director, agent, or employee of? (insert name of company above)
