
**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER GRANTING PROVISIONAL ADMISSION TO
THE BAR OF THIS COURT FOR ATTORNEYS EMPLOYED BY THE
FEDERAL DEFENDER PROGRAM, INC.**

Effective immediately, attorneys employed by the Federal Defender Program, Inc., who reside within this district but are not yet members of the State Bar of Georgia will be allowed 18 months from the date of their appointment within which to become members of the State Bar of Georgia, provided that they at all times are members in good standing of the bar of another United States district court. These attorneys will be deemed provisionally admitted to the bar of this Court until they are formally admitted.

Attorneys who are employed by the Federal Defender Program, Inc., who do not reside in this district need not be admitted to practice before this Court provided that they at all times are members in good standing of the bar of another United States district court.

The Court is in the process of amending its local rules to reflect the above changes. To the extent this order is inconsistent with any local rule of the Court, this order controls.
