

**GENERAL ORDER 23-01**


**WHEREAS**, the Judicial Conference of the United States, the national policy-making body for the federal courts, announced that its district court pilot program to evaluate streaming live audio of proceedings in civil cases of public interest will end on March 31, 2023;

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia volunteered to be and was designated a pilot court; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 27, 2021, the Court entered General Order 21-02 to authorize and set forth rules for the pilot program;

**NOW THEREFORE**, General Order 21-02 is hereby **VACATED** effective at the close of business on March 31, 2023.
